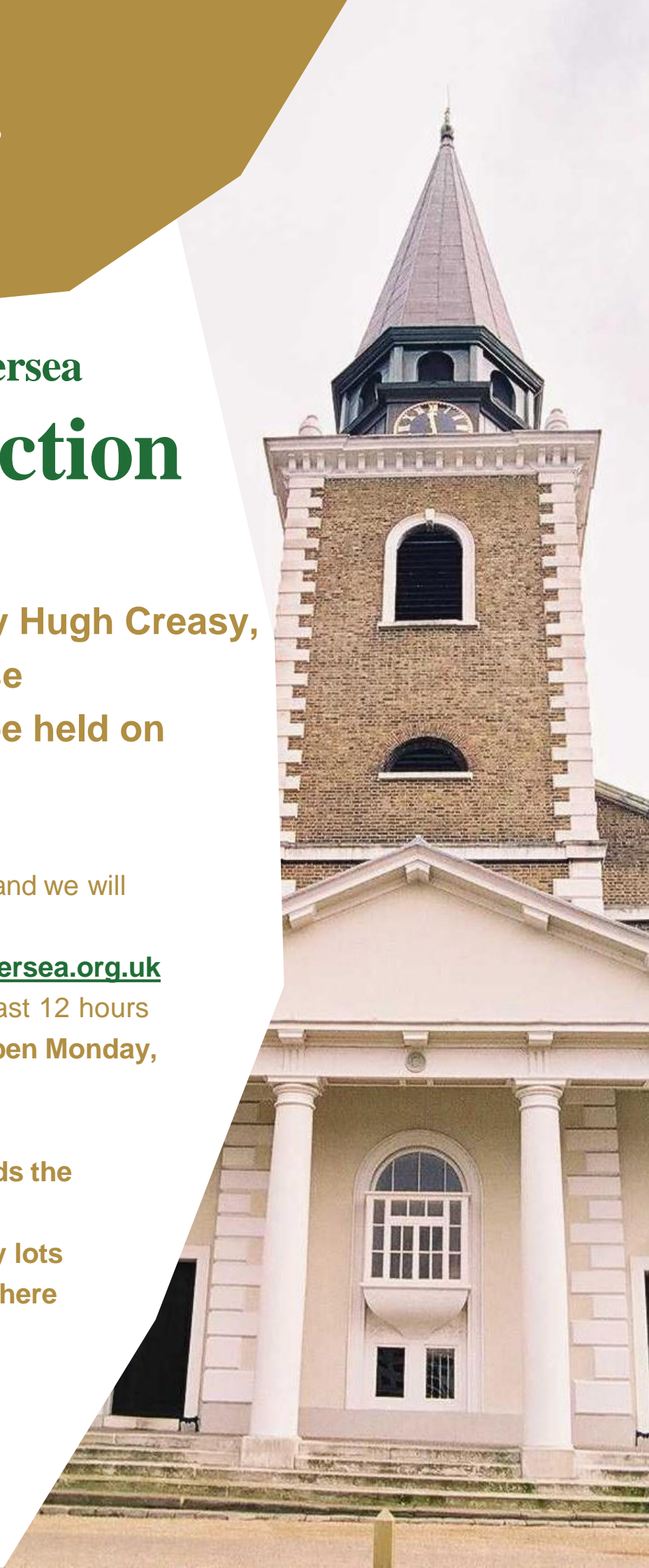

supporting our historical Grade 1 listed building and grounds through the **Friends of Battersea Parish Church** to preserve the building and grounds of **St. Mary's Church Battersea**.

For over twelve hundred years, St Mary's, Battersea has stood on the banks of the River Thames and is the only Grade 1 listed Church in Wandsworth.

Whether for public worship, private prayer, concerts, or art exhibitions, our church continues to play a key role within our community. The funds raised from this auction will assist in keeping our ancient building as a place of living history, beauty and inspiration, and one that looks to serve the wider community of all faiths and none.

There are some capital projects needed to maintain the building and keep it up to date in serving our community. All proceeds of the auction night will not only help preserve the past – it will be a pledge to the future.

Key Projects to be funded

- **The repair and renewal of the churchyard river wall.** Our churchyard is protected from the Thames by the river wall. This is now requiring structural repairs to ensure the wall does not collapse.
- **Boiler repair fund.** Our Church is heated by two 40+ year old gas boilers. These will need to be replaced in the new few years with a more efficient method of heating
- **Repair and update external lighting of the building.** Currently our external flood and pathway lighting is failing and needs to be replaced. This will ensure the church remains a stunning visual landmark in the evenings and our public paths are safely lit.

These projects are estimated to be in the region of £200,000 so our action will play a key part in our fundraising efforts to meet this.

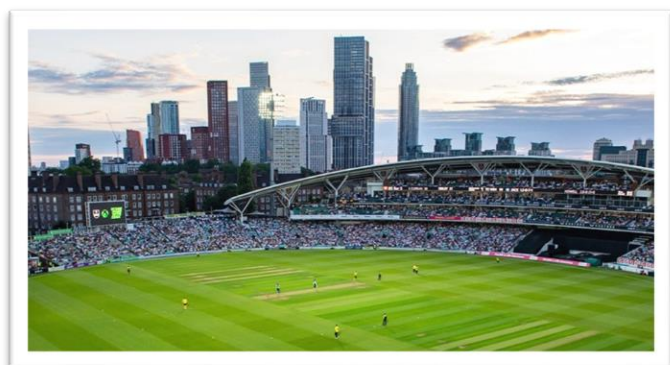

8 Cannon Balls



Used in the British Navy from 1590 to 1716 when bigger guns were favoured, these two cannon balls referred to as round shot were used in the Navy's smallest gun, the Minion which was 1000lbs in weight and 8 feet long. These two cannon balls are 2 7/8" diameter and had a maximum range of 1000 paces, but at their most accurate and deadly at 150 paces. The pair were found under Battersea Bridge by a mudlarker in summer 2024, most likely to have fallen off a ship sailing up the Thames. They are unlikely to have ever been used. No Reserve

Artist Julian Barrow

Julian Barrow Born: 28 August 1939 Died: 3 September 2013.

Julian was an established and widely collected painter of town and landscapes. He painted mostly in oils and executed more than 1,000 pictures in his career. His style was defiantly traditional but his skill in matching colours gave his paintings real energy and a beguiling charm and warmth. Barrow was a well known figure in Chelsea and had acted as an enthusiastic president of the Chelsea Art Society. He often exhibited at the Royal Academy and had his last solo exhibition in New York in May 2013.

For the Queen's Silver Jubilee in 1977 he produced a portrait of the House of Lords which now hangs at Westminster and embarked on a series of interiors of London clubs such as the Garrick, White's and the Beefsteak.

For much of his career Barrow lived in Tite Street in Chelsea, overlooking the Thames.

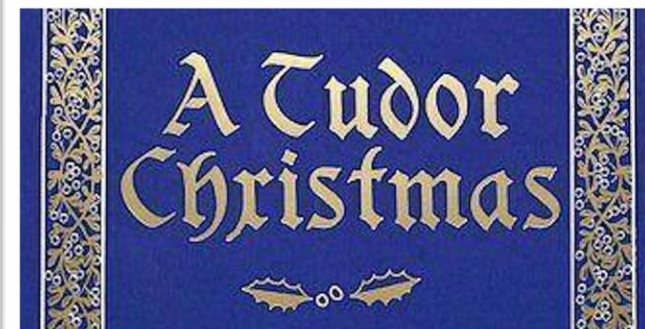
Tour of Houses of Parliament

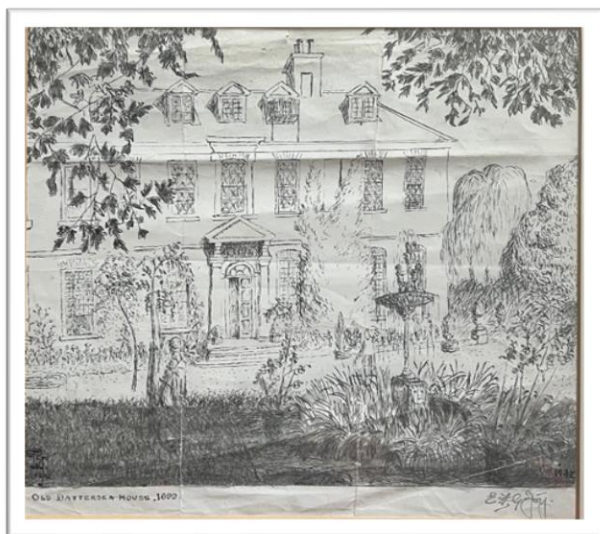

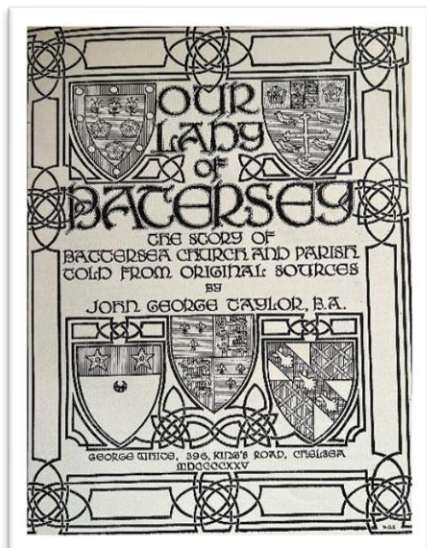

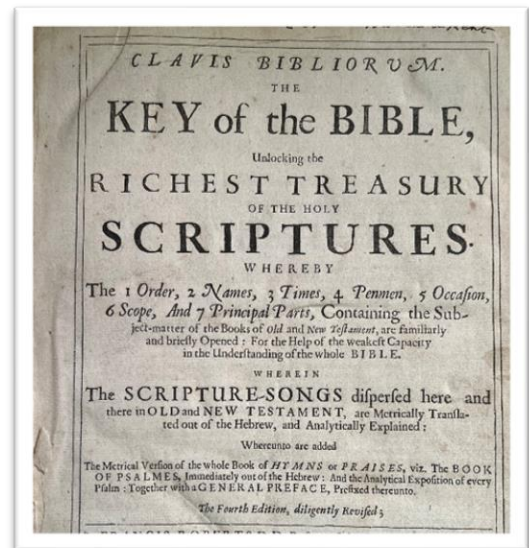

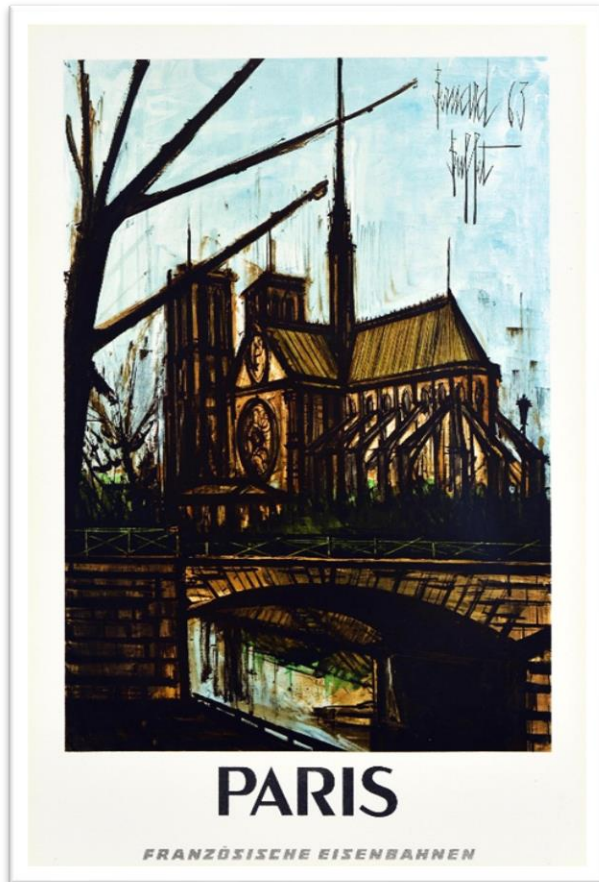
