For over twelve hundred years, St Mary's, Battersea has stood on the banks of the River Thames and is the only Grade 1 listed Church in Wandsworth.

Whether for public worship, private prayer, concerts, or art exhibitions, our church continues to play a key role within our community. The funds raised from this auction will assist in keeping our ancient building as a place of living history, beauty and inspiration, and one that looks to serve the wider community of all faiths and none.

There are some capital projects needed to maintain the building and keep it up to date in serving our community. All proceeds of the auction night will not only help preserve the past – it will be a pledge to the future.

#### Key Projects to be funded

- **Repair and update external lighting of the building.** Currently our external flood and pathway lighting is failing and needs to be replaced. This will ensure the church remains a stunning visual landmark in the evenings and our public paths are safely lit.
- **Repair and Restoration of our Portico:** The beautiful front part of our building. The paintwork and stonework will be restored to it's previous glory!
- **Boiler repair fund.** Our Church is heated by two 40+ year old gas boilers. These will need to be replaced in the new few years with a more efficient method of heating

These projects are estimated to be in the region of £200,000 so our action will play a key part in our fundraising efforts to meet this.

# **St Marys Concert Painting: Richard Gower**



#### Richard Gower – BA – Born 1962 UK

Studied at Batley College of Art in the 1980's where he specialised in fine art and sculpture. Over the years Gower has developed a unique style with his 'Reflections' series Throughout his career Gower has painted in a variety of styles, taking inspiration from Modern Masters such as Sickert, Monet, Picasso and Bacon and over the past few years has developed his recognisable painting technique finding great success with his 'Reflections' work. Observation are key to Gower's practice. Capturing moments in sport or day to day life.

Gower has enjoyed sell-out group and solo shows in Central London art galleries, with many of his works now in private collections across the UK, Europe and the US. He has also worked on a number of private commissions, including family portraits, a London cityscape for the Lord Mayor of Westminster, a bespoke commission for the Duchess of York and Purdey Guns to name but a few. In 2017 Richard Gower painted a portrait of HRH Prince Phillip's last official engagement which is now held in The Royal Collection.
